# First United Methodist Church

*New Ulm, Minnesota*

**T**he congregation of the United Methodist Church worked hard to raise the funds for an elevator addition to make their historic church building accessible to all who want to worship and fellowship there. The present brick structure was built in 1924. The exterior facade of the addition was designed to match the existing building as closely as possible, with brick, limestone trim and a red clay tile roof.

The three-stop elevator provides access to the kitchen and fellowship hall in the basement and the sanctuary on the first floor. A new elevator lobby was also added onto the second story as the entry point to the Sunday School rooms.
